What we are looking for.

More than ever this year we are looking for locally crafted and handmade, as well as the locally grown and cooked. Preference will be given to stall holders that make and create. Please send photos of your creations for consideration by the stalls co-ordinator.

Selection Criteria

Stalls will be chosen based on a number of factors. In particular stall applications that meet the following criteria will be looked upon most favourably:

- Australian arts and crafts and other locally handmade goods.
- Original, unique, high quality goods.
- Stalls of a musical nature, i.e. musical instruments.
- Creative clothing.
- Quirky and fun stalls.
- Organic or environmentally friendly products.
- Ethically sourced and sustainable goods.

We will not accept stalls that sell:

- New or second hand electrical items.
- Mass produced goods, especially those imported from overseas.
- Illegal or counterfeit items.
- Explosives of any kind.

- Any product deemed not suitable for a g-rated audience.

Makers at Majors

For 25 years Majors Creek Festival has encouraged and supported emerging musicians. We are extending this to the rich community of artisans and crafters who wish to share their talents with us at Majors in 2018. We will be offering discounted stalls in recognition of the time, effort and cost in preparing locally handmade items for us all to enjoy. Upload photos with your application for consideration for the Australian handmade stall fee.

Food or coffee stalls - \$250

Snacks or sweets stalls - \$170

Australian handmade craft stalls - 3m x 3m - \$90

Australian handmade craft stalls - 6m x 3m - \$170

Quality craft/wares stalls - 3m x 3m - \$150

Quality craft/wares stalls - 6m x 3m - \$235

Stall fees include two free camping tickets. Extra tickets – children under 18 may camp for free.

Every extra camper over 18 must buy a ticket. Please let us know when applying if you need extra tickets.

Food Stalls

When applying you will need to provide your copy of current NSW Food Authority License and Food Safety Certificate. Council inspectors inspect all food stalls prior to opening on Friday afternoon and may ask for copies of these certificates.

Water is limited at Majors Creek and is for festival visitors as well as stall holders. Please be prepared and bring your own water supplies to the festival.

Green Initiatives

Majors Creek Festival is proud of its focus on low waste and green initiatives and this extends to all areas of the festival. At the discretion of the stalls co-ordinator a refundable green bond of \$120 will be issued with your invoice. If you meet the requirements below then your green bond will be refunded after the festival.

As a food stallholder, you will be required to serve all food on biodegradable/compostable plates, cutlery and cups. Either bamboo or 100 per cent paper plates only. NO 'biopak' clear cups or lids please as they are commonly mistaken as plastic and contaminate our recycling stream. We will provide you with bins for your green waste that will be collected over the weekend by our wonderful waste team and then sent to be composted.

There are to be no plastic bags provided to your customers. If bags are needed for your product please provide paper bags.

Helpful Info

Majors Creek Festival is held on the Majors Creek Rec ground. It can get cold, it can get windy and it can get hot! Sometimes all of these in one day.
