Selection Criteria - What are we looking for?

Stalls will be chosen based on a number of factors. In particular stall applications that meet the following criteria will be looked upon most favourably:

- Australian arts and crafts and other locally handmade goods.
- Original, unique, high quality goods.
- Stalls of a musical nature, i.e. musical instruments.
- Creative clothing and quality retro wear.
- Quirky and fun stalls.
- Organic or environmentally friendly products.
- Ethically sourced and sustainable goods.

We will not accept stalls that sell:

- New or second-hand electrical items or bric-a-brac
- Mass produced goods, especially those imported from overseas.
- Illegal or counterfeit items.
- Explosives of any kind.
- Any product deemed not suitable for a g-rated audience.

Not-for-profit community groups.

Are you with a local community organisation? We have a number of free stalls to offer to such groups. Please apply via the link below. Please note stalls will be accepted or rejected at the discretion of the Festival Committee.

| Quality craft/wares stalls - 3m x 3m | \$150 |
| Quality craft/wares stalls - 6m x 3m | \$235 |

Food Stalls

You will need to provide your copy of current NSW Food Authority License and Food Safety Certificate. Council inspectors inspect all food stalls prior to opening on Friday afternoon and may ask for copies of these certs.

Water is limited at Majors Creek and is for festival visitors as well as stallholders. Please be prepared and bring your own water supplies to the festival.

Green Initiatives

Majors Creek Festival is proud of its focus on low waste and green initiatives and this extends to all areas of the festival. There are to be no plastic bags provided to your customers. If bags are needed for your product's please provide paper bags.

Food Stalls Only - at the discretion of the stalls co-ordinator a refundable green bond of \$120 will be issued with your invoice. This will be refunded after the festival providing you meet the following:

- All food is served using biodegradable/compostable plates, cutlery and cups. Either bamboo or 100 per cent paper plates only. NO bio plates, they contaminate our recycling stream.
- All food scraps are placed in bins provided. This will be collected over the weekend by our wonderful waste team and then sent to be composted.
- No glass bottles are sold as glass is banned on the reserve as part of our licence agreement

Stallholder commitment

- Stalls must be open and ready to trade the following hours but can opt to trade outside of these hours at own discretion;
 - Friday 5pm - 8pm
 - Saturday 9am – 8pm on Saturday
 - Sunday 9am – 3pm

(Note* 9am starts exclude food stalls that do not serve breakfast which are welcome to commence trading later)

- No smoking anywhere on the recreation reserve, behind tents or otherwise. Please use smoking area located on the tennis courts or outside of the recreation grounds and remember to PICK UP YOUR BUTS!
- Camping behind stalls limited to stallholders and will be one set up only. If you have approved extra workers for your stall, they are welcome to camp in the main free camping area. Any other guests of your stall will be required to buy tickets via the website or at the gate on arrival.
- Please remember no vehicle movements on the recreation reserve from from 3pm Friday till pack down at 3pm on Sunday. If you think you may need your vehicle please park it outside the grounds after you have unpacked your stall

Armbands and festival entry

The following armbands will be issued. 2 x weekend passes for market stalls and 3 x 3 snack stalls and 3 x weekend passes will be issued for food stalls. Any passes above this can be purchased at super early bird prices. Note that under 18's are free

Cancellation

For stalls cancelled between the 16th Sept and the 10th October a half refund can be issued or a full refund if a suitable replacement for my stall can be found. If a stall is cancelled after the 10th October no refund will be offered.
